Eagle projects:

When: 4th Thursday of every month at 6pm. The Scout requesting an Eagle project review must contact the Eagle Coordinator at the above email no later than the Monday preceding that month's review date.

Where: St. Luke's UMC at 1394 East 9 Mile, Pensacola Florida

What: BSA publication 512-927 (January 2021 version) is the only acceptable format at this time. The Scout should wear a complete Scout uniform and bring their workbook with a completed project "Proposal" with supporting documentation to include: sketches, maps, drawings, pictures, log book/journal etc... ready to talk about their project. Project organization is vital! **Workbooks must also include dated beneficiary and Unit Leader signatures on page H**.

Eagle Boards of Review:

When: 4th Thursday of every month. 5:30pm for board members, 6pm for Eagle candidates. Eagle boards are requested by the Scoutmaster through Mark Lynn at the above email after he/she has received the application from Cyndi in the council office. Preferably after several reference letters have been received. The Scoutmaster must request the Eagle BOR no later than the Monday preceding the board requested.

Where: St. Luke's UMC at 1394 East 9 Mile, Pensacola Florida

Who: **The Scout:** shall be in a complete Scout uniform including merit badge Sash.

The Troop: shall provide at least 2 and up to 4 committee members one of whom will be assigned as the board chairperson. Scoutmasters and ASM's may not participate as board members; however, having the Scoutmaster present the candidate to the board is highly recommended.

The District: will provide 2 representatives to sit the board.

What: The Troop representatives should have all required documents including the original application with the Scouts "statement of ambitions and life purpose", un-opened reference letters, and original Eagle Scout Service Project workbook (multiple copies are recommended). Additional documentation which may be applicable such as camping logs, leadership history, Scout handbook etc. is encouraged.

Our goal is to continue to provide the best possible Board of Review experience for every Scout. We believe that these Scouts will remember their experience and as tomorrow's Scouters they will look to provide just as positive an experience for their Scouts! We are continually seeking input that will help us improve the process and hope to answer any questions as quickly as possible.
